Message from the Head Teacher

Dear Parents / Carers,

I think you will be pleased to hear that as part of the continuous care for the emotional wellbeing of your children as well as yourselves, we are going to introduce monthly 'Drop in' sessions with our school counsellor.

Claire, our school counsellor, has already been successfully working with some of our children. The feedback received from the children and their parents has always been very positive. Claire has extensive experience in behaviour and emotional problems that we all experience from time to time. You may wish to seek her advice or simply share your issues; sometimes talking about the issue is enough to make you feel reassured. We recognise that at times you or your children may have problems or concerns you wish to discuss, without the commitment to any regular support.

Please remember that the service is completely confidential, the only exception will be a child protection issue. In any other cases, Claire won't share or discuss your problems with the school without your full co-operation and clear indication that this is what you want.

The first session available is on 21st November at 12:15 to 1:00pm. Please let the office know if you would like an appointment. You can book a telephone appointment, should you be unable to come to school.

I hope you will find these sessions useful.

Please make note that Claire will also be available on 12th December, again between 12:15 and 1:00pm.
