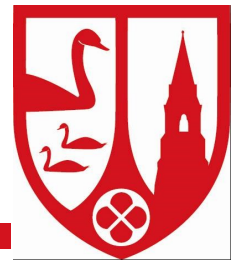

Simply follow these instructions:

Go to the 'Reading Cloud' website at **<https://U021737.microlibrarian.net>**

Log in using the number on your library bookmark (or in your reading record) as both the username and password.

Type in the title of the book that you want to review in the top, right-hand box, and click on the search icon.

Click on the title of the book when it appears.

You will see a green tab entitled '**Create Review**' to the right-hand side of the book. Click on this.

Type your review in the box and click on how many stars you would give it. Click 'save'.

One of the librarians will check your review before publishing it. This will then be displayed on the website alongside your book for others to read.

And you may inspire someone else to read that book!

How to write a book review:

Include the **title** and **author** of the book;

Give a **summary** of the **main parts** of the story;

Don't give away any plot twists, or the ending, as this will spoil it for others;

Make it sound as exciting and interesting as possible;

Tell the reader whether you **enjoyed** the book or not. Give **a reason** for **your opinion**;

Check it over at the end for any mistakes. Read it aloud.

Take a look around the 'Reading Cloud' website whilst you're there to see what other fantastic features it has.

It's your school library online, so use it!
