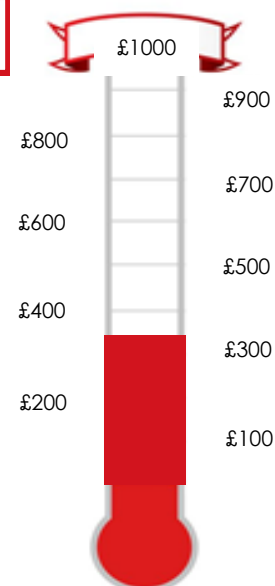

We hope to see lots of our talented kids showcasing their skills so whatever your act - singing, dancing, acting, magic, comedy, music or anything else - we want to hear from you!

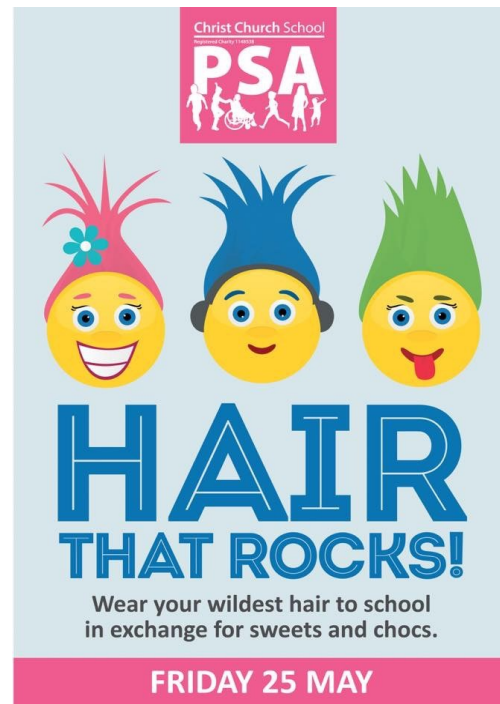
