Lost Property

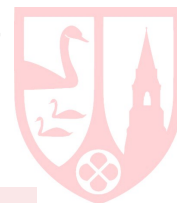
A black Ware Lions coat with the number 12 on it has gone missing. If found please return to the school office as soon as possible. Many thanks.

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Every child at Christ Church is expected to be correctly dressed for school. A list of our uniform is given below.

Uniform items can be purchased through our appointed stockists at www.kidsconnection.co.uk or at their store; Kids Connection, Hertford, SG14 1DQ.

Girls

White polo shirt
Grey skirt / trousers / pinafore
Christ Church cardigan or sweatshirt
White / grey socks
White / grey / red tights
Black low heel shoes (no trainers, boots, sandals or ballet style pumps)
Red quarter inch check summer dress
Hairbands preferably red

Boys

White polo shirt
Grey trousers or shorts
Christ Church sweatshirt
Grey socks
Black shoes (no trainers)

Nursery – optional

Christ Church sweatshirt or cardigan

All items must be clearly named!

PE kit (Named and stored in a drawstring bag and kept in school)

House colour t-shirt
Red shorts
Plimsolls– indoor wear (KS1 to wear for indoor & outdoor)
Trainers– outdoor wear (KS2 only)
Tracksuit bottoms for cold weather use

Hair

Hair that is shoulder length or below must be tied back, whether on boys or girls. We do not allow extreme hairstyles – this includes stripes / shapes shaved into hair, Mohicans, spikes, coloured hair etc. Gel and similar products are not permitted.

Jewellery

No jewellery may be worn to school, other than a plain watch (which must be removed for PE) and earrings (gold or silver studs only, need to be covered with tape or plasters for PE).

No nail polish should be worn to school
