Christmas Dinner & Jumper Day

We will be holding our annual Christmas Lunch on Wednesday 13th December. All children in school are invited to have lunch that day, even if they don't normally do so. Your child may choose a Traditional Lunch, a Vegetarian Lunch, or may bring a packed lunch from home - there will be no school packed lunch option that day.

If your child does not normally have school meals and has a food allergy, can you please indicate below and we will advise on the process for reporting this.

Children in Reception, Year 1 & Year 2 are entitled to free school meals, which includes Christmas Lunch.

The Christmas Lunch costs £2.35 for Years 3-6, the same cost as a normal meal. Meals must be paid for in advance, so please make sure your child has sufficient credit on their meal account. Payment can be made via School Gateway, Cheque (payable to Christ Church School) or Cash in a named envelope.

Everyone must complete the slip below and return no later than Wednesday 8th November 2017. Requests cannot be added or changed after this date.

Please note that as usual children will be allowed to wear Christmas jumpers on this day also.
