

Termly Evaluation of P.E. Action Plan

Objective – To improve Teachers subject knowledge to ensure P.E. is being taught effectively.

This is an area that we have highlighted as important. This year we feel there has been a lack of support for staff. We have employed a basketball coach this year. He has worked with all teachers throughout the year and teachers feel they have gained from his knowledge and expertise.

Next year we also have secondary school teachers coming to work with children and insets set aside for staff training. This will be monitored by lesson observations and staff questionnaires.

Staff development will be an ongoing objective next year also.

Objective – To improve pupil premium children's involvement in extracurricular sport.

This objective has shown great improvement this year. We have had the largest percentage of pupil premium children attending sport events and being involved in clubs. We have targeted specific children, inviting them to events. They have also all been part of our basketball sessions both within lessons and during lunchtime clubs.

We have a sport coach at lunch times. As a staff we have also seen a larger number of pupil premium children getting involved and joining in games. A meeting has been arranged to discuss what is working well and how we could further improve this service.

This objective will continue into next year, however huge progress has been made.
